

VEHICLE MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST



- Change your oil and filter
- Check and/or change air filter and cabin air filter
- Check and/or change your battery (if more than 3 years old, change it)
- Check belts and hoses
- Grease all fittings on suspension and drivetrain
- Ensure your visibility by changing wiper blades
- Check for chips or cracks in windshield, (replace if cracked, fill chips if chipped)
- Inspect your tires and air them to MFG specs if replacement is not necessary
- Inspect your brakes and change pads and rotors if worn or grooved
- Inspect shocks and struts for wear and/or leaks, replace if necessary
- Check your antifreeze and flush if needed*
- Fill washer fluid reservoir
- Check power steering fluid, brake fluid, and transmission fluid (replace and flush any or all if dirty.) *
- Clean your fuel injectors
- Replace fuel filter
- Inspect your radiator and thermostat
- Check your lights all around vehicle (replace with LED for even better visibility)
- Protect your exterior and interior with a good cleaning and wax

**Power steering, brake, transmission, and antifreeze should be changed and flushed if over 50K miles.*
