

# Sweet Potato Slip Starting Guide



#### Sprout your own sweet potatoes ste-by-step with this easy guide!

### // Prep. Gather Your Supplies

- Organic sweet potato
- Wooden picks (toothpicks or bamboo skewers)
- Glass jar or container
- Sunny windowsill or grow light
- Optional: Seed-starting heat mat

### TGG Grow: Start the Sprouting

- 1. Choose a healthy sweet potato.
- 2. Insert wooden picks around the middle to hold it halfway in a jar of water.
- 3. Place the root end in the water, sprouting end facing up.
- 4. Set in a sunny, warm spot use a heat mat if needed.
- 5. Keep the water clean and topped off.
- 6. Watch for slips (sprouts) to grow from the top!

#### 🦪 Root: Grow Strong Slips

- 7. Once slips have several leaves, gently cut them from the potato.
- 8. Pinch off all but the top 3-4 leaves.
- 9. Place each slip in a jar of clean water.
- 10. Allow strong roots to form.
- 11. When roots are well developed, your slips are ready to plant!

## Quick Tip:

Before you start, check the sweet potato carefully. The root end is usually more tapered, while the sprouting end is rounded with tiny "eyes."
